



Mustang Equipment and Volunteer Policy:

We are looking for many ways to keep the Milford Mustangs a safe and growing organization while keeping our costs down. The costs continue to rise for equipment and the need to keep equipment certified each year. An equipment deposit will be required on the day equipment is handed out. Also, the need for volunteers is vital to our organizations existence. We will also use the deposit toward volunteer time called our Mustang Roundup.

The equipment deposit is simple, when you get your equipment it is your responsibility to return that same equipment on the equipment turn-in day at the end of the season. Any missing equipment or missed volunteered time will be subject to a fee.

Volunteering is a way to keep our organization costs at a minimum. The Mustang Roundup (Volunteer) assignments may consist of Gate/ticket taker, Chain Gain, Clock manager, Spotter, Announcer, Concession Stand, Griller/Cook, 50/50 Drawing, Pre-game setup and Post Game breakdown/cleanup. The parent/guardian for each player is responsible to sign up for 3 volunteer positions (approximately 3 shifts, 2 hours each). Each volunteer assignment will ONLY be at our home field on game days. We would encourage each volunteer to either plan their time before or after their player's game, we do not want you to do your volunteer time during your children(s) game.

How does this work and how to sign up?

It all starts on the Equipment Day Handout, each player will sign-out their equipment and is responsible for that equipment until the end of the season.

A Mustang Roundup sign up sheet will be available to select your date and times to volunteer. The minimum volunteer requirement is 3 two-hour shifts. Once you sign up you will be responsible for that time, in the event you need to change you will need to find a replacement or work with the Mustangs Volunteer Coordinator. Each team's Unit Director will assist in coordinating and verifying that each home game has appropriate volunteers.

This check will be held until the end of the season. Once the equipment is turned and verification that the volunteering has been completed, the check will be RETURNED on the Equipment Turn-In day.
